

Year 2022 achievements

What we accomplished by the grace of God.

Upon facing the uncertainty of a season still in lockdown by COVID-19, as a church, we decided it was wisest and more prudent to move forward on the goals which would represent the development and growth of our church this season.

Throughout the year we knew that what our church needed was to strengthen the relationships between its current members and the establishment of our church's culture, and to be able to serve —in a more specific way— the members of our church in every stage of their life.

So, this year we achieved:

- 1. The official launch day of our church planting through a weekend-long celebration.
- 2. A growth in volunteers, from being 30 volunteers to closing the year with 68 as our main team.
- 3. A growth in church attendance, starting this year with 60 attendees and closing 2022 reaching the 112 attendees mark.
- 4. We organized special events for specific groups from the church.
- 5. We held meetings for new members where we intentionally introduced them to our culture, vision, and pillars as a church



When he first came to our church, he was a very shy and you could tell the sadness he was feeling by his physical expression.



All of this events happened during this whole year.








Events


